

Dual Enrollment Scores – ESCJ Eligibility

Academic Dual Enrollment:

- Students must be eligible prior to the start of class.
- Students must be in grade 11, 12, or an Early College participant.
- Students must have a cumulative unweighted grade point average of 3.0 and maintain a 2.0 college GPA.
- Students must be tested in Reading, Writing and Math when taking PERT for the first time.
- Students must demonstrate readiness in reading and writing.
- Students must demonstrate readiness in math when exceeding 12 college credit hours and/or enrolling in a math or science course.

Scores required as of 10-22-13. Math Course Placement effective 02-08-16 (PERT) & 03-15-16 (SAT/ACT).

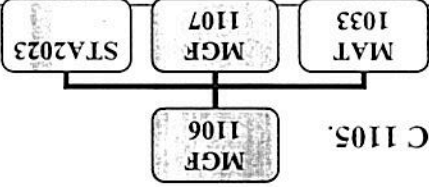
